ORDINANCE, 2001

Sindh Ordinance No. XL of 2001

AN ORDINANCE

to provide for computatory education in the Province of Minth.

WHEREAL It is expedient to provide for compulsory education in the Province of Sindh;

AND WHEREAC the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No.1 of 1999;

AND ANDREAD the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immedicate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the afore-said Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No.9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the fovernor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate following Ordinance:

CHAPTER-I PRELIMINARY

- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Compulsory Primary Education Ordinance, 2001.
- (2) This section and section 2 shall come into force at once and such other provisions of the Ordinance shall come into force in such areas and or such dates as Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, specify in this behalf: provided that this Ordinance, shall be enforced in all Districts by June 2004.

Definitions: 2. In this Ordinance, unless there is anything regugnantisin the subject or context with the subject of context.

- (a) "Authority" means an Authority appointed under section 5;
- (5) "child" means which of retther, the begining of the school year, In not least than five years and not more than eleven years.
- (c) "Government" means the Government of Sindh;
- (d) "parent" includes a guardian on any other person who has the custody of a child;

- (e) "primary education" means the education pertaining to all or any of the classes I to V, in a school;
- (f) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Ordinance;
- (E) "primary school" means a primary school maintained by Government and includes a school or Department of a school recognized by Government as suitable for imparting primary education.

CHAPTIER - II

COMPULSORY PRIMARY EDUCATION

- 5. Subject to other provisions of this Ordinance, the primary education shall be compulsory for every child in the Province.
- The parent of a child shall, except in the case of a reasonable excuse, cause a child to regularly attend a primary school until the child has completed the primary education.

Exploration: For the purpose of this section, reasonable excuse includes any of the Collowing causes :-

- (a) Where the child is prevented from attending a primary school by reason
 - of electropies we montal in-capacity of an any attention uncayattable cause;
 - (b) where the child is receiving, otherwise them in a primary school, instruction which, in the opinion of the Education Officer concerned is sufficiently.
- (c) where there is no primary school within a distance of one kilometer measured according to the regrest route from the residence of the child.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AUTHORITY

- 9. (1) lovernment shall appoint one or more Authorities for the purpose of this Ordinance.
- (2) The Authority shall ensure that every child required to attend a primary school under this Ordinance attends a school and for the purpose—it shall take such steps as may be considered necessary by it or as may from time to time be specified by Government.
- (5) There the Authority is satisfied that a parent who is required under this Ordinance to cause a child to attend a primary school, has failed to do so, the Authority, after giving the parent an opportunity of being heard and after such inquiry as it considers necessary, may by an order direct the parent to cause such child to attend a primary school on and from a date which shall be specified in the order.
- (4) The Authority may exercise such power or perform such functions as may be prescribed.

OFFENCES

6. (1) Any parent who fails to comply with an order issued under sub-section (3) of section 5 shall be punishable with fine which may extend to fifty rupees and with a further fine which may extend to twenty five rupees for every day after the conviction if the failure continues.

- (*) any person who, after receiving due warning from the Authority continues to employ a child, who is required under this Ordinance to attend the primary school whether on remuneration or otherwise, shall be punishable with time which may extend to fifty from any with a further fine which may extend to twenty five rupees for every day after the conviction if the failure to attend a school continues due to such employment.
- (3) No court shall take cognizance of any offence under this section except on a complaint in writing made by the Authority.

POWER TO MAKE RULES

7. Government may make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Ordinance.

REPEAL

8. The Sindh Primary Education Ordinance, 1962 is hereby repealed.
