01. The members of YPF may contest the election for the following honorary positions of YPF Board:

 02. The candidates shall submit their nomination papers as per the timeline given in the Election Schedule.
 03. The Members of YPF are expected to vote for all the positions of YPF Board.
 04. For every nomination, a Member of YPF will be required as Proposer.
 05. Nomination paper must be filled in complete in all respect and duly signed by the Candidates and their Proposers.
 06. Nomination paper can be downloaded from official website, and is also available in the office of Secretary, Provincial Assembly of Sindh.
 07. Duly filled in nomination papers shall be submitted to the Secretary office, Old Sindh Assembly Building, as per Election Schedule.

POLLING INSTRUCTIONS

- a) The election will be held through secret ballot.
- b) Each member shall have one vote against each position.
- c) Polling Booth will be established in the Old Assembly Hall, Sindh Assembly Building.
- d) Ballot Papers will be issued to the Members of YPF appearing in the YPF Voters List.
- e) Each YPF Member before entering the polling booth must note his/her **Serial Number** from the YPF Voters List affixed outside the Polling Booth (also circulated in advance) and inform the Polling Staff of his/her respective Serial Number.
- f) The voters will be issued the ballot paper **AFTER presenting CNIC/Assembly ID Card.**
- g) Each ballot paper will have the names of contesting candidates (validly nominated for election) with a check box in front of the candidate's name.
- h) YPF Members/Voters will be required to affix a **tick sign** **inside the check box** of his/her preferred candidate with a **blue ballpoint**, which will be available at the polling booth.
- i) **Polling Agents** would be assigned a dedicated area within the polling station (Old Assembly Hall).
- j) Before delivering a ballot paper to each voter, it will have to be signed by the Presiding Officer and also stamped on its reverse with the seal of the Provincial Assembly of Sindh to be valid.
- k) After receiving the ballot paper, the voter will proceed to the enclosure and put a tick mark inside the check box.
- l) The ballot paper will be folded before it is inserted in the ballot box, which will be placed on the table in front of the Returning Officer.
- m) **Cancellation and Reissuance of Fresh Ballot Paper in case of Spoilt Ballot:** A spoilt ballot paper is one that has been accidentally/incorrectly stamped, marked or torn or otherwise altered so that it cannot be used as a valid ballot paper.
 - A voter can return a spoilt ballot paper to the Returning Officer **(BEFORE CASTING IT IN THE BALLOT BOX)** in exchange for a new one. A new ballot paper will be issued to the voter in the same way as before.
 - However, in case such a ballot paper is casted, no new ballot paper will be issued.
- n) When voting time ends, the Returning Officer will open the ballot box, count all the ballot papers in the presence of the candidates or their polling agents, and will announce the names of the Elected Board Members.
